



MATERIALS

Size USG6/4.00mm crochet hook Medium/worsted weight yarn -beige -dark brown (for nose) -white -light blue Black safety eyes (6mm) Polyester fiber-fill stuffing Stitch marker Blunt end tapestry needle Ribbon Because of his small size, I consider Mochi one of my Amigurumi "gems". (Other gems will be available in the near future) He is quick and easy to make and doesn't require much yarn. Experiment with different colors and create your own bunny army! Consider making these as adorable and unique party favors! Or attach a key ring to the top of the head and he can become a cute little zipper pull for a backpack! There are endless possibilities! Have fun and happy crocheting!!



HEAD

use beige yarn		
Rnd 1:	4sc into magic ring	
Rnd 2:	2sc into each st [8]	
Rnd 3:	(sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [12]	
Rnd 4:	(2sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [16]	
Rnd 5:	(3sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [20]	
Rnd 6:	(4sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [24]	
Rnd 7:	(5sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [28]	
Rnd 8-9:	sc around [28]	
Rnd 10:	(4sc, sc2tog) repeat around [24]	
Rnd 11:	(3sc, sc2tog) repeat around [20]	
Rnd 12:	(2sc, sc2tog) repeat around [16]	
Rnd 13:	(sc, sc2tog) repeat around [12]	
Fasten off and leave a tail		

Assembly:

Stuff the head and position the eyes. Then take your dark brown yarn and tapestry needle and sew the nose. Tie the yarn ends tightly within the head so it can't ever pull out. Attach the ears. Yay! You're finished with the head! (Make sure you remember to affix the safety backings onto the eyes!!)



EARS

Rnd 1:4sc into magic ringRnd 2:2sc into each st [8]Rnd 3-8:sc around [8]Rnd 9:sc2tog, sc, sc2tog,3sc		use beige yarn		
Rnd 3-8: sc around [8]		Rnd 1:	4sc into magic ring	
		Rnd 2:	2sc into each st [8]	
Rnd 9: sc2tog, sc, sc2tog,3sc		Rnd 3-8:	sc around [8]	
		Rnd 9:	sc2tog, sc, sc2tog,3sc	
Fasten off and leave a tail				

BODY

use blue yarn		
Rnd 1:	6sc into magic ring	
Rnd 2:	2sc into each st [12]	
Rnd 3:	(sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [18]	
Rnd 4:	(2sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [24]	
Rnd 5:	sc around [24]	
Rnd 6:	(3sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [30]	
change to white yarn		
Rnd 7:	(3sc, sc2tog) repeat around [24]	
Rnd 8:	sc around [24]	
Rnd 9:	(2sc, sc2tog) repeat around [18]	
Rnd 10:	sc around [18]	
Rnd 11:	(sc, sc2tog) repeat around [12]	
Fasten off and leave a tail		



FEET use beige yarn Rnd 1: 6sc into magic ring Rnd 2: 2sc into each st [12] (sc, 2sc into next st) repeat around [18] Rnd 3: Rnd 4: sc around [18] Rnd 5: (sc, sc2tog) repeat around [12] Rnd 6: (2sc, sc2tog) repeat around change to blue yarn Rnd 7: (2sc, sc2tog) repeat around

ARM

use beige yarn			
Rnd 1:	4sc into magic ring		
Rnd 2:	2sc into each st [8]		
Rnd 3:	sc around [8]		
change to white yarn			
Rnd 4:	(sc, sc2tog) repeat around		
Rnd 5-6:	sc around		
Fasten off and leave a tail			



TAIL

	use beige yarn		
	Rnd 1:	4sc into magic ring	
	Rnd 2:	2sc into each st [8]	
	Rnd 3:	sc around [8]	
Fasten off and leave a tail			

ASSEMBLY

-Stuff the body and attach to head -Attach arms

-Attach legs

-Attach tail

-Take ribbon and tie a nice neat bow around bunny's neck. Snip the ends neatly with sharp scissors.
